Thank you for your e-mail dated 25 May with attached letters addressed to me and the Secretary of State for Transport respectively. As you know, the Committee has accepted the corrections made by the Secretary of State for Transport to the DfT's evidence to our inquiry into Roads Policing and Technology. The Committee accepted that the error had occurred inadvertently, and concluded that this did not affect our recommendations because speed cameras and Vehicle-activated signs (VAS) serve quite different functions. Consequently, the Committee is not minded to amend its recommendations, and neither does it intend to reopen its inquiry.

The Committee may well revisit these issues in future road safety inquiries, but for the time being, I consider this matter to be closed, and I shall instruct my staff not to enter into any further communication on it.
